William H. Beeson, M.D., is a facial plastic surgeon. In addition to his private practice, he serves as a Clinical Professor at the Indiana University School of Medicine in the Department of Otolaryngology/Head and Neck Surgery and in the Department of Dermatology.

He has written numerous medical textbooks on cosmetic surgery and contributed articles and expertise as advisory board member to a host of medical journals such as American Journal of Cosmetic Surgery, Journal of Dermatologic Surgery and Journal of Cutaneous Laser Surgery.

Dr. Beeson is active in many medical organizations and is a past president of the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery, as well as the Indianapolis Medical Society and the Indiana State Medical Association. He has served as a delegate to the American Medical Association from 1995 - 2006 and is a past chair of the AMA's Council on Medical Service. In addition, he sits on the Joint Commission's Sentinel Event Advisory Committee, and the American National Standards Institute Subcommittee on Safe Use of Lasers in Healthcare Facilities. He is a past president of the International Society for Cosmetic and Laser Surgeons and is current president of the Aesthetic Stem Cell Society.

Dr. Beeson has long been involved in ambulatory surgery organizations and is a past president of the Federated Ambulatory Surgery Association. He served on the Board of the Directors and is a past president of the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care. He has served on the Board of Directors and the Board of Governors of the National Patient Safety Foundation. He was appointed by the Governor to the Indiana Hospital Licensing Council, where he served for seven years, chairing the Council's Ambulatory Surgery Subcommittee. He recently completed an eight year tenure as a member of the Medical Licensing Board for the State of Indiana, including serving as its president.

Since receiving the Dean's Award upon graduation from the Indiana University School of Medicine in 1976, Dr. Beeson has earned the Distinguished Alumni Award from Indiana University, the Scholastic Award from the American Society of Head and Neck Surgery, and both the Webster Award and the President's Award from the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery. In 2005 he accepted the John Clark Award from the Federation of State Medical Boards for significant contributions to patient safety and quality medical care. He was named by Governor O'Bannon a "Sagamore of the Wabash" and received the "Distinguished Hoosier Award" from Governor Daniels in 2007.

A native Hoosier, Dr. Beeson completed residencies at Methodist Hospital and Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis, and a fellowship with the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. He is board certified in otolaryngology and cosmetic surgery as well as facial plastic and reconstructive surgery.
